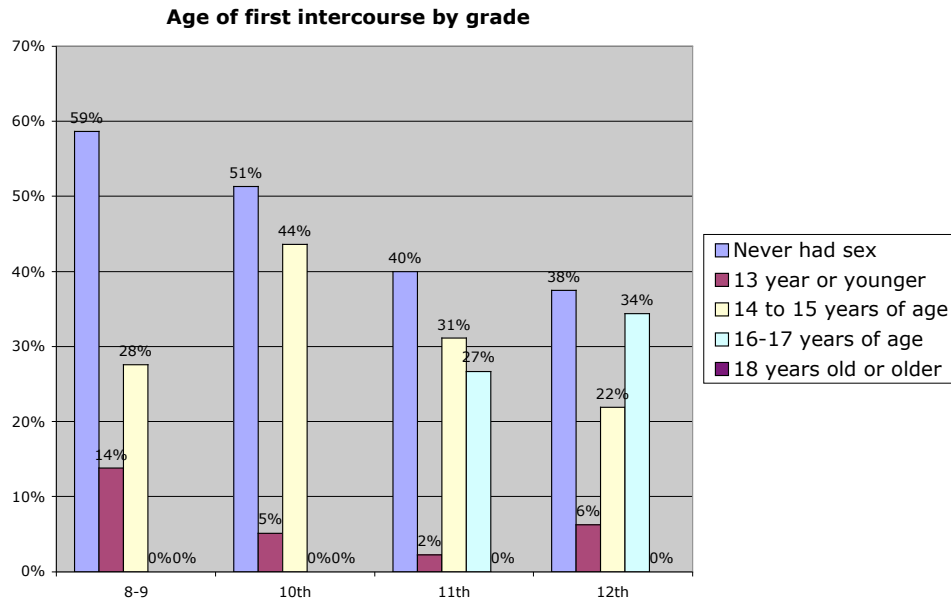
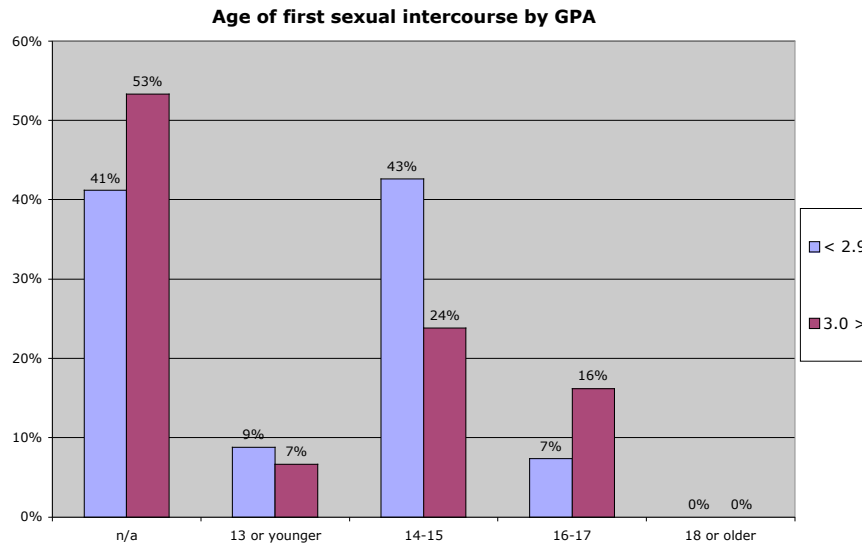


## Sexual Behavior



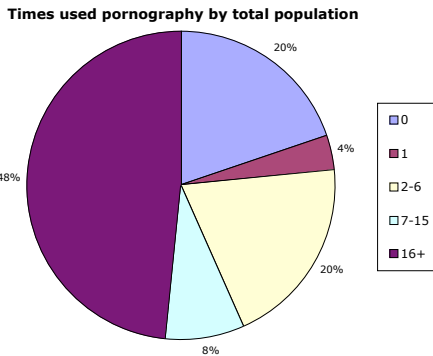
It is self evident, as the above chart indicates, that over the course of their high school years more students will start having sex. What is notable, however, is the indication that students are starting to have sex at a younger age. Twice as many 10<sup>th</sup> graders reported having their first intercourse between 14 and 15 years of age as compared to seniors 44% and 22% respectively. In contrast, 5% of this year’s sophomore class reported age of first intercourse was 13 years younger, 28% of 2003 sophomores reported the same.



Of those students with <2.9 GPA, 43% reported having had their first sexual intercourse between ages 14 and 15, as compared with 24% of those with a GPA >3.0 whose first sex was at this age. Of those students with <2.9 GPA, 41% reported not having had sex as compared with 53% percent of those with a GPA >3.0. Therefore, students with a lower average GPA are more likely to begin sexual activity at a younger age.

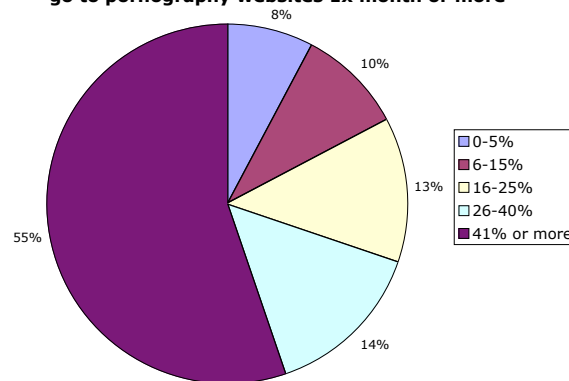
## Pornography Use

Ready access to pornography is a problem. DVDs and websites with pornography are ubiquitous. Some students seem to trade them as if they were baseball cards. Even with sophisticated filters students find multiple ways to access porn through the TSA ACADEMY server. The following charts identify the pervasiveness of this activity through a variety of parameters including use at school and use away from school.



Having been at school longer would appear evident that seniors have used pornography at school more often. Frequency of use as indicated by, “how often do you go to pornography websites while at TSA ACADEMY” was nearly equal across classes, with the majority of student reporting going to such sites once a week. What might be notable however, is that those with a  $3.0 >$  GPA are 2x more likely to visit pornography websites at school 1x per day or more as compared with students whose reported GPA is  $< 2.9$ .

Fifty-five percent of the student population estimated that over 41% of TSA ACADEMY students visit pornography websites 1 time a month or more. The reported percentage is 30% use 1 time a month or more at school, and 62% use 1x a month or more away from school.
